Gardeners from Texas stay at a beautiful mountain farm, enjoy tours to gardens/plantations, and conduct volunteer gardening and educational activities with Mayan kids. This trip includes tours of coffee and macadamia farms; garden tours of an organic vegetable garden, a botanical garden, and a private ornamental garden; plus day trips to the colonial city of Antigua, Lake Atitlan and the Iximche Mayan Ruins

Visit spectacular gardens, nurseries, coffee plots and shops around the Spanish colonial city of Antigua.

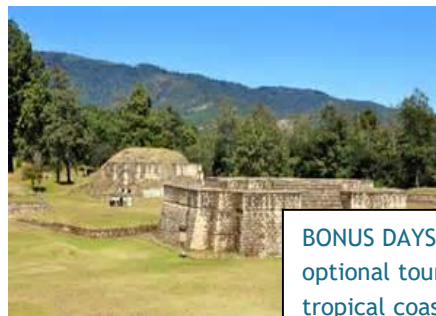
Lake Atitlan & Boat Tour
