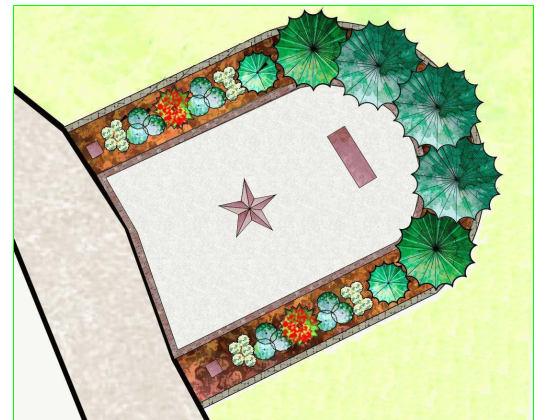


# Tomb of the Unknown Soldier Never Forget Garden Veterans Memorial

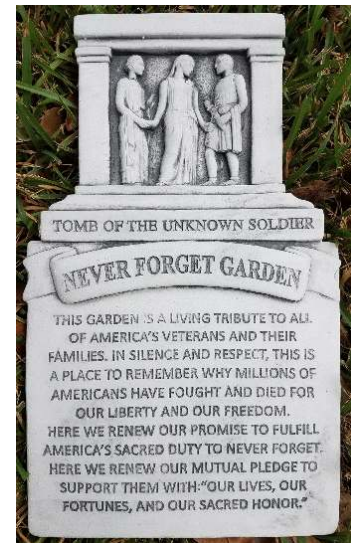


TAMU Horticulture Landscape Design - Adapted for Printing



The Never Forget Garden Veterans Memorial will include a:

- Standing Granite monument with wreath symbolizing the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.
- Never Forget Garden Plaque from the Honor Guard Society of the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.
- Memorial Garden.
- Park bench for visitors to reflect and "never forget" our patriots.



The Never Forget Garden Veterans Memorial is a joint project of numerous community groups including, but not limited to, local chapters of the Daughters of the American Revolution [DAR], local Sons of the American Revolution Chapter [SAR], A&M Garden Club and other local garden clubs, organizations, veterans, and numerous individuals. Cost for this project is estimated to be approximately \$70,000 to \$100,000.

In addition to paying tribute to all missing and unknown veterans, this memorial will also honor the thousands of soldiers who died during the American Revolution, many buried in mass graves.
