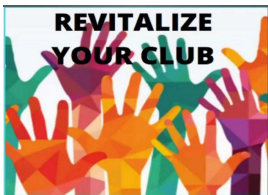

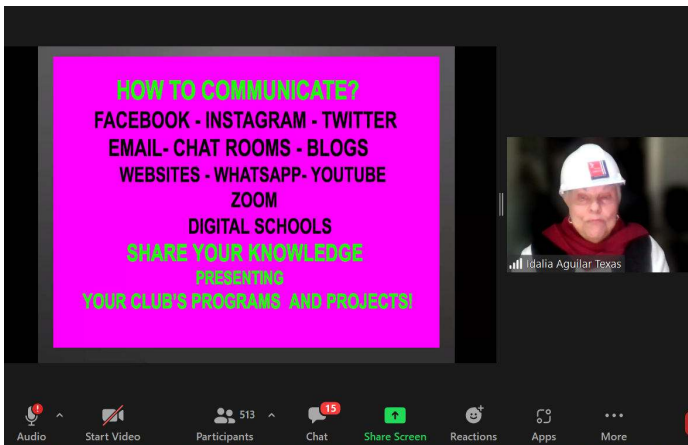
## NGC Membership

Sign up for 2022-23 committees at the potluck meeting on May 13. Participate and get better acquainted with other GC members.

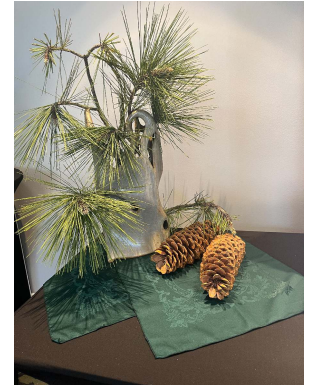
